



Circuito iridato Firenze- Fiesole

(giorni di Giovedì 26 mattina, Venerdì 27 mattina e, limitatamente alle fasi di gara in cui i corridori si saranno tutti immessi sul circuito iridato, Venerdì 27 pomeriggio, Sabato 28 e Domenica 29).


The closing and opening hours are indicated in the maps.

In this specific case, the race will take place solely on the Firenze-Fiesole race track, composed by the following streets: Viale Paoli, Viale Fanti, Viale Calatafimi, Viale Righi, Piazza Edison, Via di San Domenico, Fiesole, Togliatti, Salviati, Bolognese, Trento, Trieste, Bolognese, Ponte Rosso, Mafalda di Savoia, Via Pascoli, Don Minzoni, Cure overpass (Cavalcavia delle Cure), Viale dei Mille.

The main roads from Viali di Circonvallazione and from its relative connections to the south of Florence (Sud Firenze) and Gavinana (Lungarni Percori Giralardi, del Tempio, Colombo) will remain open.

Moreover, city access through Via Bolognese and Via Faentina will be blocked. Anyone who usually enters the city through these roads will have to use preferably the A1 highway (Autostrada A1) from Mugello or, only in the case of light vehicles the S.P. 130 to get from Via Bolognese to Sesto Fiorentino.

The use of Via Bolognese until Via Massoni is limited to light vehicles of riparians and of those with situations of utmost importance in the Ospedale di Careggi. Via Massoni will be inverted (from Via Bolognese towards Careggi) in order to be used to access the hospital area. Via di Terzollina and Via di Capornia will become a one way streets from the Via di Careggi towards the Via Bolognese direction.



In this phase, while there are no particular problems regarding the general viability (the Viali di Circonvallazione are open in all directions), the area encircled by the race track will not be accessible (unless in serious cases of health emergencies). Please note that crossing the race track in any way during the course of the race is not allowed, unless it is by foot. Therefore,

anyone who needs to enter/leave the area contained inside the race track must absolutely do so before the beginning of the closure of Via Pistoiese.
