Objectives and activities: The goal is to engage the citizen and LEA (law enforcement agency) in mutual learning of local policing practices, exchange information and alerts, and provide for a platform to develop inclusive problem solving methodologies. The platform will provide information to the public about the goals and responsibilities within community policing. A training scheme, including the use of serious games, will be developed to assist the training of officers and citizens in the uptake of the community policing app

and portal. The project will outline best practices for police cooperation with the public, directly for community engagement, the use of technology in community policing, and to establish community policing policies in LEAs.
