

Hydrogeological Risks Emergency instructions

If you find yourself inside a building

- 1. Do not go outside; remain where you are. Staying in the building will protect you more than being out in the open.
- 2. Hide under a table, in a doorway, or near supporting walls. They can protect you in case of collapse.
- 3. Move away from windows, doors with glass and cabinets. If they fall, they could hurt you.
- 4. Do not use elevators. They could get stuck and prevent you from getting out.

If you find yourself outside

- 1. Move away from buildings, trees, lampposts, and telephone and electrical lines. If they fall, they could hurt you.
- 2. Do not go on a road that has material that fell from a landslide. This material is unstable and could start moving again.
- 3. Do not go on the body of a landslide. It may seem stable, but you can get stuck or fall through.
- 4. Do not enter houses without first having an expert look. There may be structural damage.
