

## Industrial Risks Emergency instructions

When the risk of contamination is high, the responsible authorities may order an evacuation according to the predetermined emergency evacuation plan, which also provides information on exit and collection points.

- 1. Follow the safety instructions indicated in the information provided by the mayor to make sure that safety measures and rules of conduct are known.
- 2. Obtain information with the radio and TV. Listen to the instructions given by the authorities and the measures that must be taken until everything is safe.
- 3. In case of toxic emissions from a nearby factory, remain in a closed space.
- 4. Pay attention to the information given by authorities through loudspeakers, signs, and other means. They can provide useful information on the ongoing situation and what measures should be taken.
- 5. To reduce the exposure to toxic substances, close doors and window cracks with wet tissues and turn off air conditioners and ventilators to avoid exchanging air with the outside.
- 6. Stay away from the dangerous areas and stay tuned to the local radio. This will ensure your air stays reasonably clean and will give information on what to do post-emergency.
