MAY 2014

The camp, Spring stage 2014 will see the participation of 130 players from all over Italy and Morocco and allow you to evaluate the specific training needs of the Crescent Mehdia The project, approved at national level by the Red Cross, also aims to initiate a long term partnership with its sister Moroccan and activate periodic exchanges and targeted training with particular attention to young people. During the meeting the ambassador highlighted the characteristic aspects of Ghana and Togo and stressed that Ghana is a country outstanding among the African countries for the pursuit of peace and coexistence of different religions; it is homeland to a great symbol of peace like Kofi Annan, the historic United Nations Secretary and Nobel Prize for Peace. Ghana is a country devoted to peace, a theme dear to the city of La Pira, as it is one of the leading African countries for contributions of troops for peace-keeping forces to the UN International which is also training center. This year the government of Ghana has the presidency of ECOWAS, the Economic Community of West African States, which includes 15 African countries (*see Highlights*).

SEPTEMBER 2014

The Taiwanese Ambassador outlined the economic aspects of his country and Taiwan investments on the Italian territory (above all in the in the field of luxury hotels). Italy is the fourth largest trading partner of Taiwan, which is a strategic bridge between the USA and China. The island enjoys a stable political situation and an excellent logistics infrastructure. Mayor Nardella took the opportunity to invite the Mayor of Taipei by way of the Ambassador of Taiwan to the Conference of the Mayors for Peace scheduled for October 2015 in Palazzo Vecchio. In turn, the Ambassador Kao invited the mayor of Florence to make a stop in Taipei during his next mission in China. The province of Florence is linked by a twinning agreement to the administrative district of Darmstadt-Dieburg (belonging to the Land of Hessen) since 2005 and many municipalities in the province of Florence are twinned with the same number of municipalities in the province of Darmstadt-Dieburg, economically very wealthy and dynamic. Darmstadt, in particular, also known as the city of science, is the seat of the ESA (European Space Agency) as well as major companies in the chemical-pharmaceutical industry. Mayor Nardella has expressed much interest in continuing the relationship and the many initiatives with the province of Darmstadt-Dieburg also in view of the metropolitan city (*see photo gallery*).
- 39. **30/10** Councillor to international relations and cooperation Nicoletta Mantovani met the Minister of Culture of the Arab Republic of Egypt, the Hon. Gaber Asfour, in Palazzo Vecchio. A visit of the Minister to the National Archaeological Museum of Florence followed: the museum is home to a rich collection of artefacts and relics of the ancient Egyptian civilization.
